



CHÂTEAU D'ARVIGNY

Haut-Médoc AOC

2nd wine of Ch. Beaumont & Barrière exclusivity.

Château Beaumont was built in 1854 in a splendid Renaissance style.

Today, the estate is under the guidance of Mr. Philippe Blanc (Ch. Beychevelle).

Located on the left bank of the Gironde, between the communes of Margaux and Saint-Julien, Château Beaumont draws its finesse and its delicacy from the deep gravels of the best soils of the Haut-Médoc.

Château Beaumont has opted for integrated viticulture, following the technical specifications of Terra Vitis®, aiming to produce quality grapes with the greatest respect for the environment.



VINEYARD:

- Varietals: 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc
- Soil: Topsoil of thick gravel and a subsoil of clay limestone.
- Size of the vineyard : 105 ha
- Age of the vine: 40 years
- Planting density: 6700 vines/ha
- Average Yield : 48 hl/ha
- Harvest: The harvest is done by machine

WINEMAKING:

- Vinification: following a sorting process, the vinification takes part in temperature controlled stainless steel vats. Gravity is used to protect the grapes during alcoholic fermentation.
- Ageing: After fermentation the harvest goes partly into oak barrels.
- Bottling: at the chateau

TASTING NOTES:

A soft, supple, fruit forward styled Haut-Médoc. Red berries, soft tannins and low acidity make the wine smooth and elegant thus a good ambassador for an appellation.
