



CHÂTEAU BEAUREGARD DUCASSE

Cuvée Lagupeau

Graves A.O.C

Beauregard Lagupeau is situated in the south of the Graves AOC.

With an altitude of 112 meters, this vineyard is one of the highest in the appellation. It has been owned by the same family since 1850, and today the sixth generation of winemakers is represented by Jacques and Marie-Laure Perromat.

Beauregard also produces an excellent red wine !



VINEYARD:

- Varietals: 70% Sémillon, 30% Sauvignon
- Soils: Sandy-gravel on a typical deep gravel-clay subsoil
- Size of the vineyard: 10 ha
- Age of the vine: 25 years
- Planting density : 8 000 vines/ha
- Average Yield : 45 hl/ha
- Harvest : by hand

WINEMAKING:

- Vinification : stabilisation and pre-fermentation skin-contact maceration (5-8° C), the juice is then vinified in temperature-controlled stainless-steel vats.
- Ageing: in stainless steel vats for a minimum of 8 months.
- Bottling: at the chateau

TASTING NOTES:

This dry white wine has an elegant and fruity bouquet. On the palate, it is lively and fresh with wonderful balance between the acidity and ripe fruit flavours. Long finish with notes of almonds.
