



# CHÂTEAU BEAUREGARD DUCASSE

## Cuvée Lagupeau

### Graves A.O.C

Beauregard Lagupeau is situated in the south of the Graves AOC. With an altitude of 112 meters, this vineyard is one of the highest in the appellation. It has been owned by the same family since 1850, and today the sixth generation of winemakers is represented by Jacques and Marie-Laure Perromat. Beauregard also produces an excellent white wine !



#### VINEYARD:

- Varietals : 55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc.
- Soil : sandy-gravel on a typical deep gravel-clay subsoil.
- Size of the vineyard: 10 ha
- Age of the vine: 25 years
- Planting density : 8 000 vines/ha
- Average Yield : 45 hl/ha
- Harvest: by hand

#### WINEMAKING:

- Vinification: fermented & vinified in stainless steel vats with controlled temperatures. The vatting lasts between 15 and 21 days.
- Ageing: the wine is aged in oak barrels of which 25% are renewed each year.
- Bottling: at the chateau

#### TASTING NOTES:

Firm and rich structure for this "classy" Graves. Fine and elegant aromas of leather and dried plum with a sufficient touch of new oak to give it even better complexity and depth. A wine with the distinctive and typical Graves character!
