



DIVIN DE CORBIN

A.O.C Saint-Emilion

Château Corbin, situated in the Saint Emilion AOC on the border of the Pomerol appellation, is one of the patriarchs of Saint-Emilion. Its foundations date back to the 15th century, and according to legend Corbin, was the stronghold that belonged to the “Black Prince” Edouard de Plantagenet who fought the French in the early stages of the Hundred Year War. Since 1999, the estate is managed by Anabelle Cruse-Bardinet, a Bordeaux University oenology graduate, who represents the 4th generation of the family to lead the Chateau.



VINEYARD :

- Varietals : 80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet franc
- Soils : Clay and sandy-clay with ferric clay subsoil
- Size of the vineyard : 13 ha (by the border of Pomerol)
- Age of the vine :15-20 years
- Planting density : 7 500 vines/ha
- Average Yield : 35 hl/ha
- Harvest : By hand with double sorting

WINEMAKING :

- Vinification: Plot by plot vinification in concrete vats. Maceration 3-4 weeks
- Ageing: In French oak barrels
- Bottling: At the Château

TASTING NOTES :

Divin offers in its dark dress a wonderful expression of pure and concentrated dark fruit. The palate is immediately seduced by the structure of its body: juicy, fresh with fine and elegant tannins. A divine wine that will charm all palates!
