



CHÂTEAU HAUT GAUSSENS

A.O.C Bordeaux

Château HAUT GAUSSENS is a family owned property of 15 hectares situated on a privileged terroir of Verac village just by the border of the Fronsac appellation. Under the management of Stephane Lhuillier since 2000 (3rd generation of winemakers in the family) the quality of the wines has known a thundering improvement due to the environmental friendly viticulture and the investment made in the cellar.



VINEYARD:

- Varietals: 90% Merlot, 5% Cabernet franc et 5% Carmenère
- Soils: Clay & limestone
- Size of the vineyard: 15 ha
- Age of the vine: 35 years
- Planting density: 4 500 vines/ha
- Average Yield: 50 hl/ha
- Harvest: by machine

WINEMAKING:

- Vinification plot by plot in stainless steel vats with temperature control
- Maceration: 3 to 4 weeks
- Ageing: in vats
- Bottling at the Château

TASTING NOTES:

Intense purple color. Beautiful red fruits and spices on the nose. Fresh and fruity the wine opens towards an intense medium-full body with velvety power, which is quite exceptional for the vintage.
