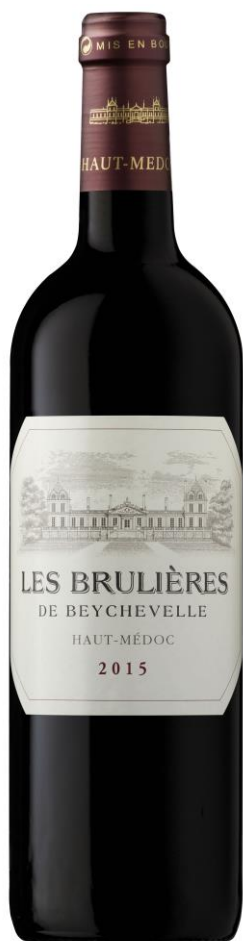




LES BRULIÈRES DE BEYCHEVELLE

Haut-Médoc A.O.C

“Brulières” is the Beychevelle wine coming from the 12 hectares located just south of Saint-Julien. The vineyard belongs to **Château Beychevelle**. Vineyard management and winemaking is carried out by the same Ch. Beychevelle team head by Mr. Philippe Blanc.



VINEYARD:

- Varietals: 56% Cabernet Sauvignon, 44% Merlot.
- Soil: gravel and clay
- Size of the vineyard: 12 ha
- Harvest: partially by hand

WINEMAKING:

- Vinification: the grapes are brought to Château Beychevelle for an initial sorting
- Bottling: at the chateau

TASTING NOTES:

Medium to full bodied with attractive, rich, plummy-berried fruit aromas. Excellent balance, structure and length. Brulières is a stand-out classic Claret rivaling most of the better Bourgeois wines.
