



SOLAIA TUSCANY

The Antinori family of Florence, one of the world's oldest and most distinguished wine producers, has lived in Tuscany since the 14th century and celebrated its 625th anniversary as wine makers in 2010. The current company president, Marchese Piero Antinori, believes in the tradition that the primary role of wine is to accompany food and enhance the dining experience.

"Solaia" is the Antinori's iconic high-end wine produced starting with the 1996 vintage and made using a majority of Cabernet Sauvignon.



VINEYARD:

Varietals: 75 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 20 % Sangiovese
5 % Cabernet Franc

10 hectares situated at 350-400 meters above the sea level on a soil of calcareous rock (known as "alberese" in Tuscany).

WINEMAKING:

Harvest: 100% by hand

The grapes were first destemmed and then, selected on the sorting tables.

The ageing process the began and lasted eighteen months in French oak.

Bottling: at the Château

TASTING NOTES:

Freshly cut flowers, raspberries, spices, mint and licorice burst from the glass as this fabulous, viscerally thrilling wine shows off its pure class.
