



## Adrianna Vineyard Mundus Bacillus Terrae Malbec Mendoza – ARGENTINA

The story of Catena is the story of Argentine wine. Founded in 1902, Argentina's Bodega Catena Zapata is known for its pioneering role in resurrecting Malbec and in discovering extreme high-altitude terroirs in the Andean foothills of Mendoza. The family's Adrianna Vineyard at almost 5,000 feet elevation has been called the Grand Cru of South America. Named after Nicolás Catena Zapata's youngest daughter, the Adrianna Vineyard is located at almost 1500 m elevation in Mendoza. Mundus Bacillus means 'elegant bacteria' in Latin, and is named in honor of the bacteria that live in the soil in Adrianna Vineyard.



#### VINEYARD :

Grape varieties : 100% Malbec

Parcel surface : 1,4 hectares

Soil composition : Alluvial, gravelly. Limestone topsoil

#### VINIFICATION & AGEING :

Harvest : by hand

Aging: 18 months in barrel, oak treatment is decided according to the vintage characteristics. French Oak

#### TASTING NOTES :

This richly oaked selection from the high-elevation Adrianna Vineyard in Tupungato smells of berries, red currants and maple. Red berry, red plum and wood grain are the dominant flavors.
