



DOMAINE DE BARON'ARQUES

PH. DE ROTHSCHILD - LIMOUX

The "1st Growth" of southern France! Domaine de Baron'arques is a very old estate, dating back at least to the 17th Century, when it was called Domaine de Lambert. In 1998, the estate was acquired by Baroness Philippine de Rothschild and her two sons who entrusted the management of the Domaine to the family company, Baron Philippe de Rothschild S.A.



VINEYARD:

Varietals:

- 70% of "Atlantic": 50% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc
- 30% of "Mediterranean": 10% Grenach, 10% Malbec, 10% Syrah

Located in the village of Saint-Polycarpe, near Limoux in the upper Aude Valley, Domaine de Baron'Arques stretches over 107 ha, of which 48 ha of vines are planted.

WINEMAKING:

Harvest :100 % by hand

Vinified and aged in the Bordeaux tradition,

Domaine de Baron'Arques has become the reference in the Languedoc.

The wine is aged for 12 months in oak, of which 50% is renewed every year.

TASTING NOTES:

The wine has a dense, very dark color with a violet tint and a nose that opens on fresh blackberry and bilberry, with touches of strawberry and cherry. The attack is round and smooth, with a rich and very well-rounded structure. Silky on the palate, it elegantly combines patrician tannins with generous flavors. A highly expressive finish, full, powerful and finely textured wine.

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
